





With our D8 Inter-Lock Mini Season, we need to make sure all teams are abiding by the Return to Play plans as they are laid out by each association. In order to do that we need participants to answer a 4th question during the screening process.

The Screener will be responsible for pre-screening of all participants and spectators attending a Facility (this does not include casual park users or others attending the Facility for purposes other than softball, only those who are attending the softball activities). Before any individual is allowed to go onto the diamond, or engage in either softball activities, or to be there as a spectator, they must be screened to determine if they are permitted entry. These questions must be answered by everyone and if they give a positive answer to any of the first three questions or a negative answer to the fourth, that person must be instructed to either return home, or to seek medical attention, but they are not allowed to attend the scheduled softball activities.

Screening questions are:

- Are you exhibiting any symptoms of COVID-19 (fever, dry cough, chest or respiratory pain?)
- Has any member of your household exhibited any symptoms of COVID-19 within the last 14 days?
- Have you or any other member of your household arrived from outside Canada in the past 14 days?
- Do you agree to abide by the Host association's specific Return to Play guidelines including but not limited to, spectating (allowed or not allowed), social distancing, and sanitation rules?
